Changes to OSHA Guidelines

May 26, 2021 Reissued June 2, 2021

On May 25, 2021 Oregon OSHA (Oregon Occupational Safety and Health) issued a statement aligning their policy with the recent OHA (Oregon Health Authority) document entitled "Interim Guidance for Fully Vaccinated Individuals".

Effective May 27, 2021 fully vaccinated team members and visitors of our office and fabrication shop will no longer be required to wear face coverings or social distance. To take advantage of this new guidance please provide your team leader or supervisor with verification of your vaccination.

Those that do not provide verification will be required to continue wearing face coverings and social distancing.

While this is an important first step to getting 'back to normal', <u>we are all obligated</u> to comply with our clients and customers policies when on their premises and worksites.
